- 2. THE 10 COMMANDMENTS ARE GODS ABSOLUTES FOR MORAL AND SPIRITUAL LIVING
- 3. PHARAOH ORDERS THE DEATH OF NEW BORN MALE HEBREWS
- 4. MOSES (AMRAM-JOCHEBED) IS BORN AND HIDDEN FROM DEATH
- 5. PHARAOH'S DAUGHTER FINDS MOSES IN THE RIVER FLOATING IN A BASKET
 - a. SHE KEEPS HIM AS HER SON
 - b. SHE NAMED HIM MOSES
 - c. MOSES WAS BORN FROM THE TIRBE OF LEVI
- 6. MOSES FLEES TO MIDIAN AFTER KILLING AN EGYPTIAN MAN
- 7. HE MARRIED ZIPPORAH (JETHRO) AND THEY HAD GERSHOM
- 8. GOD SPOKE TO MOSES AT THE BURNING BUSH
- 9. GOD ASKED MOSES TO LEAD THE HEBREWS OUT OF EGYPT
- 10. MOSES HAD A SLOW TONGUE SO HIS BROTHER AARON SPOKE GODS WORDS FOR MOSES TO PHARAOH AND THE ISRAELITES
- 11. GODS 1ST PLAGUE TURNING EGYPT'S WATER TO BLOOD.
 - a. PHARAOH HAD USED THE NILE RIVER TO KILL ISRAELITE NEWBORN MALES
 - b. GOD USED THE PLAGUES TO EXPOSE PHARAOH NOT TO BE A GOD TO HIS PEOPLE

- 17. GODS 7TH PLAGUE HAIL, LIGHTNING AND RAIN COME DOWN ON EGYPT

- 21. PHARAOH RELEASES THE 600,000 + ISRAELITE PEOPLE AND ALL OF THEIR LIVESTOCK
- 22. ISRAEL WAS ENSLAVED FOR 437 YEARS IN THE LAND OF GOSHEN IN EGYPT
- 23. A PERSON MUST BE CIRCUMCISED TO EAT OF THE PASSOVER MEAL
- 24. GOD LED THE ISRAELITES THROUGH THE WILDERNESS AS A CLOUD BY DAY AND FIRE BY NIGHT
- 25. PHARAOH AND THE EGYTPIAN ARMY OF 600 MEN, HORSES AND CHARIOTS PURSUED ISRAEL
- 26. GOD INSTRUCTED MOSES TO PART THE RED SEA SO ISRAEL COULD CROSS ON DRY LAND
 - a. ISRAEL CROSSED OVER ON DRY LAND IN THE EVENING
 - b. THE EGYPTIANS FOLLOWED THEM INTO THE RED SEA THE NEXT MORNING
 - c. GOD DAMAGED THE EGYPTIAN CHARIOTS TO SLOW DOWN THEIR PURSUIT
 - d. GOD INSTRUCTED MOSES TO RECEED THE WALLS OF WATER ONTO THE EGYPTIANS
 - e. EVERY EGYPTIAN THAT PURSUED ISRAEL DROWNED IN THE RED SEA

- 28. ISRAEL COMPLAINS TO MOSES IN THE WILDERNESS OF SIN ABOUT THE LACK OF FOOD
- 29. THEY ARE UNGRATEFUL FOR THEIR FREEDOM AND HAVE NO FAITH IN THE LORD
- 30. GOD HEALS BITTER WATER FOR ISRAEL TO DRINK
- 31. GOD BEGINS TO TEST THE ISRAELITES FAITH AND OBEDIENCE TO HIS LAWS
- 32. GOD PROVIDED ISRAEL WITH BREAD TO EAT IN THE MORNING (MANNA), SIX DAYS A WEEK

 - a. ALLOW OTHER RIGHTEOUS MEN TO JUDGE SEGMENTS OF THE POPULATION
 - b. THEY BRING ONLY SERIOUS MATTERS TO MOSES ATTENTION

- 3. PEACE OFFERING FELLOWSHIP WITH GOD, THANKFULNESS
- 4. SIN OFFERING UNINTENTIONAL SIN, ATTAIN PURIFICATION
- 5. TRESPASS OFFERING DEPRIVING ANOTHER OF THEIR RIGHTS
- 6. THE OFFERING MUST BE BURNED AND BE WITHOUT BLEMISH
 - a. BULL, RAM, GOAT, LAMB, TURTLEDOVE OR PIGEON
- AARON AND HIS SONS ARE CONSECRATED AT THE TABERNACLE FOR 7 DAYS.
- 8. THE PROFANE FIRE BY NADAB & ABIHU GET THEM KILLED BY THE LORD
 - a. THE LORD DEVOURED THEM WITH FIRE AND THEY DIED
 - b. MISHAEL & ELZAPHAN (UZZIEL) AARONS COUSINS, REMOVE THE DEAD BODIES
 - c. ELEAZAR & ITHAMAR (AARON) REPLACE THEIR DEAD BROTHERS AS PRIESTS
- GOD MANDATES THE LAWS OF DAILY LIVING TO THE ISRAELITES
 - a. FOOD, CLEANLINESS, DISEASE, BLOOD, SEX, MORALS
 - b. PENALTIES FOR BREAKING THE LAW
- 10. THE SABBATH SERVED AS THE SIGN OF THE MOSAIC COVENANT
- 11. GOD MANDATES THE LAWS CONCERNING PERSONAL POSSESSIONS
 - a. THE LAND, CROPS, OWNING PROPERTY, PERSONAL POSSESSIONS, SLAVES, THE POOR
- 12. GOD GIVES THE ISRAELITES THE PROMISE OF BLESSING AND RETRIBUTION
- 13. GOD MANDATES THE REDEMPTION OF PEOPLE AND PROPERTY DEDICATED TO THE LORD

NUMBERS - BOOK 4

- GOD IS HOLY AND PURE AND REQUIRES SUCH BEHAVIOR FROM THOSE WHO CLAIM HIM AS THEIR GOD
- GOD COMMANDS MOSES TO TAKE A CENSUS OF ISRAEL BY TRIBE (603,550)
- 3. THE LEVITES WERE ASSIGNED TO GUARD AND MANAGE THE TABERNACLE
 - a. THEY DID THE WORK OF THE TABERNACLE FOR THE PRIESTS
 - b. THEY WERE EXEMPT FROM MILITARY SERVICE
 - c. THEIR FIRST BORN MALES WERE A LIVING SACRIFICE TO GOD FOR ALL OF ISRAEL
 - d. THE FIRST BORN SACRIFICES WERE TO SERVE IN THE PRIESTHOOD
- 4. UNCLEAN PEOPLE WERE ISOLATED OUTSIDE THE CAMP UNTIL THEY WERE CLEANSED
- ISRAEL MOVED FROM MOUNT SANAI TO THE WILDERNESS OF PARAN
 - a. THEY SPENT 11 MONTHS IN THE SANAI WILDERNESS
 - b. THEY TRAVELED 3 DAYS TO THE WILDERNESS OF PARAN, 35-45 MILES
- GOD COMMANDS MOSES TO SELECT 70 ELDERS TO BE ANNOINTED FOR SERVICE
- 7. GOD PROVIDES QUAIL TO ISRAEL AFTER THEY COMPLAINED ABOUT LACK OF MEAT
 - a. GOD THEN PLACED A PLAGUE ON THE DEAD QUAIL
 - b. ANYONE WHO ATE OF THE QUAIL DIED
- GOD MADE MIRIAM A LEPOR FOR 7 DAYS FOR SPEAKING AGAINST MOSES
- 9. GOD COMMANDS MOSES TO SEND 1 SPY FROM EACH OF THE 12 TRIBES TO SPY CANAAN
 - a. TO SEE THE QUALITY OF THE LAND AND THE MIGHT OF IT'S INHABITANTS

- b. 10 OF 12 SPYS GAVE A BAD REPORT SAYING THEY COULD NOT OVERTAKE THE PEOPLE
- c. CALEB (JEPHUNNEH) AND JOSHUA (NUN) FELT WITH THE HELP OF GOD THEY COULD OVERTAKE THEM
- 10. GOD BECAME VERY UPSET WITH THE LACK OF FAITH THE ISRAELITES SHOWED TOWARD HIM
 - a. GOD DECLARES THAT ONLY ISRAELITES 20 YEARS OLD AND YOUNGER WOULD RECEIVE THE PROMISED LAND. THIS WOULD BE THE SECOND GENERATION OF ISRAEL
 - b. CALEB AND JOSHUA ARE THE ONLY EXCEPTIONS ALLOWED TO ENTER CANAAN
 - c. EVERYONE ELSE WOULD DIE AFTER SPENDING 40 YEARS IN THE WILDERNESS
- 11. 250 LEADERS OF THE CONGREGATION OF ISRAEL REBEL AGAINST MOSES AND AARON
 - a. THEY CHALLENGED THE AARONIC PRIESTHOOD FOR POWER
 - b. LED BY KORAH ALONG WITH DATHAN, ABIRAM AND ON
 - c. THE LORD HAD THE EARTH SWALLOW THE HOUSEHOLDS AND FAMILIES OF THE 4 MEN
 - d. THEN FIRE CAME FROM THE LORD AND CONSUMED THE OTHER 250 REBELLIOUS MEN
- 12. THE CONGREGATION OF ISRAEL COMPLAINED TO MOSES AND AARON
 - a. THEY WERE UPSET THAT GOD KILLED KORAH AND THE 250 MEN
 - b. THE LORD PUT A PLAGUE ON THE CONGREGATION KILLING 14,700 PEOPLE
- 13. GOD COMMANDS MOSES TO COLLECT 1 ROD/STAFF FROM EACH OF THE 12 TRIBES
 - a. MOSES PLACES THE 12 RODS PLUS AARON'S ROD IN THE TABERNACLE
 - b. GOD MADE AARON'S ROD PUT FORTH BUDS, BLOSSOMS AND ALMONDS
 - c. GOD CHOSE AARON'S ROD TO STOP THE COMPLAINTS COMING FROM ISRAEL
- 14. ISRAEL COMPLAINS AT KADESH ABOUT LACK OF WATER IN THE WILDERNESS
 - a. GOD INSTRUCTS MOSES & AARON TO GET WATER FROM A ROCK
 - b. MOSES TAPS THE ROCK INSTEAD OF SPEAKING TO IT THROUGH GOD FOR THE WATER
 - c. GOD IS ANGERED AT THIS ACT AND REFUSES MOSES AND AARON ENTRY INTO CANAAN
- 15. MIRIAM DIED AND WAS BURIED IN KADESH
- 16. AARON DIED ON TOP OF MOUNT HOR AT AGE 123, HIS SON ELEAZER REPLACED HIM AS HIGH PRIEST
- 17. GOD DELIVERED UP THE CANAANITES TO ISRAEL AT HORMAH
- 18. ISRAEL COMPLAINED AGAINST GOD AND MOSES WHILE LEAVING MT. HOR FOR ABOTH
 - a. GOD WAS ANGERED AND SENT FIERY SERPENTS AMOUNG ISRAEL AND MANY DIED
- 19. KING SIHON REFUSED ISRAEL PASSAGE. ISRAEL DEFEATED HIM AT JAHAZ AND TOOK HIS LAND
- 20. GOD DELIVERED KING OG OF BASHAN TO ISRAEL ALONG WITH HIS LAND
- 21. KING BALAK OF MOAB ASKS BALAAM A PAGAN WIZARD TO CURSE ISRAEL
 - a. KING BALAK FEARED ISRAEL AND WANTED TO DEFEAT THEM
 - b. GOD REFUSED TO ALLOW BALAAM CURSE ISRAEL BECAUSE THEY WERE BLESSED
 - c. GOD EMPOWERS BALAAM'S DONKEY TO SPEAK TO HIM
 - d. GOD COMMANDS HIS ANGEL TO TELL BALAAM TO SPEAK ONLY GODS WORDS
 - e. GOD USED BALAAM TO BLESS ISRAEL IN KING BALAK'S PRESENCE THREE TIMES
 - f. BALAAM PROPHECIZES TO KING BALAK ISRAEL'S FUTURE DESTRUCTION OF MOAB
- 22. ISRAEL COMMITS HARLOTRY WITH THE WOMAN OF MOAB
 - a. GOD IS ANGERED AND HAS MOSES HANG ALL OF THE ISRAELITE OFFENDERS
 - b. GOD PUTS A PLAGUE ON ISRAEL KILLING 24,000 ISRAELITES
 - c. PHINEHAS (ELEAZER) KILLS ISRAELITE MAN AND HIS MIDIANITE WIFE TO STOP GOD'S CURSE
 - d. GOD COMMANDS MOSES TO ATTACK THE MEDIANITES FOR SEDUCING ISRAEL MEN

- 23. GOD COMMANDS MOSES AND ELEAZER TO TAKE A SECOND CENSUS OF ISRAEL (601,730)
- 24. GOD TELLS MOSES TO INAUGURATE JOSHUA AS ISRAEL'S NEW LEADER, REPLACING HIM
- 25. GOD TELLS MOSES HE WILL DIE ON MOUNT NEBO AFTER VIEWING THE PROMISED LAND
- 26. ISRAEL DEFEATS THE MEDIANITES KILLING ALL THE MEN, KING BALAK AND BALAAM
- 27. THE TRIBES OF GAD AND REUBIN WANT TO SETTLE LAND ON THE EAST SIDE OF THE JORDAN
 - a. THE PROMISED LAND OF CANAAN WAS ON THE OTHER SIDE OF THE JORDAN RIVER
 - b. GOD ALLOWED IT BUT THEY MUST GO TO WAR WITH THE OTHER 10 TRIBES
 - c. THEY COULD NOT RETURN TO GILEAD UNTIL CANAAN WAS CONCURED BY ISRAEL
- 28. GOD HAD MOSES APPOINT 6 CITIES OF REFUGE IN THE PROMISED LAND
 - a. ACCIDENTAL MANSLAYERS MAY FLEE TO THEM FOR SAFETY
 - b. THEY STAYED THERE UNTIL THEIR TRIAL BEFORE THE CONGREGATION
- 29. MURDERERS WERE AVENGED BY A BLOOD RELATIVE OF THE DECEASED
 - a. THEY MUST BE EXECUTED TO MAINTAIN THE PURITY OF GODS PEOPLE
- 30. WOMAN MUST MARRY WITHIN THEIR TRIBE TO KEEP GODS INHERITANCE FROM MOVING TO OTHER TRIBES OR CLANS

- 1. GOD RECOUNTS TO MOSES THE BLESSINGS HE GAVE TO ISRAEL DURING THEIR EXODUS
- 2. ISRAEL REFUSAL TO ENTER CANAAN DOOMED THEIR FIRST GENERATION
- 3. GOD DELIVERED UP KING SIHON OF HESHBON AT JAHAZ
 - a. ISRAEL LEFT NO SURVIVORS AND TOOK ALL OF THEIR CITIES
- 4. GOD DELIVERED UP KING OG OF BASHAN AT EDREI
 - a. ISRAEL LEFT NO SURVIVORS AND TOOK ALL 60 OF THEIR CITIES
 - b. KING OG WAS A REMNANT OF THE GIANTS, HIS BED WAS 13 st FEET LONG
- 5. GOD DIVIDED THE TRANSJORDAN LAND EAST OF THE JORDAN RIVER
 - a. MANASSEH TOOK THE REGION OF ARGOB
 - b. REUBENITES AND GADITES TOOK AREOR AND HALF OF GILEAD
- 6. GOD TOLD JOSHUA NOT TO FEAR ANY KINGDOM HE BATTLES
- 7. MOSES ASKS GOD TO LET HIM ENTER CANAAN AND IS REFUSED
- 8. MOSES COMMANDS ISRAEL TO FOLLOW THE 10 COMMANDMENTS
- 9. MOSES WARNS ISRAEL TO WORSHIP ONLY THE ONE TRUE GOD AND DISTAIN IDOLS
- 10. MOSES SETS UP 3 REFUGE CITIES LOCATED IN MANASSEH, REUBEN AND GAD

- 4. MICAH PROPHESIES THE COMING OF JESUS FROM BETHLEHEM AND HIS GREATNESS

NAHUM – BOOK 34

- 1. NAHUM WAS A PROPHET FROM ELKOSH THAT PROPHESIED JUDGEMENT OF NINEVEH

- 3. GOD COMMANDED THAT JUDAH WORSHIP HIM PROPERLY AND LOYALY
- 4. GOD GRANTED ONE LAST CALL FOR REPENTANCE OR JUDGEMENT WOULD COME TO JUDAH
